1	Is it an open competition ?	Yes.	26-Jun-15
2	Who has to be the leader : the architect or the civil engineer ?	The lead consultant should be an architect or design engineer.	26-Jun-15
3	Would you please tell us how many team will be selected to compete?	It is anticipated that six teams will be shortlisted.	26-Jun-15
4	If we are not the winner is there any competition price? If so, what is its amount?	Shortlisted teams will receive an honorarium of £5,000.	26-Jun-15
5	I understand that if we are not the lead consultant (i.e. subconsultant) then we can be on more than one team - provided the personnel involved are different. However, if we are lead designers in one team, would you be happy for us to also be subconsultant in another team? (again, with different personnel / Chinese walls).	Yes, this is acceptable, providing different personnel is proposed.	26-Jun-15
6	Is there a prize for the winner?	It is anticipated that the winner will be contracted to deliver the services described in the Expression of Interest document, however English Heritage reserves the right to determine the final composition of the design team appointed to carry out the project.	26-Jun-15
7	The EOI documentation implies that English Heritage will appoint the winning design to design the bridge, but doesn't seem to say so clearly anywhere. What is the intention?	It is anticipated that the winner will be contracted to deliver the services described in the Expression of Interest document, however English Heritage reserves the right to determine the final composition of the design team appointed to carry out the project.	26-Jun-15
8	The cost of the bridge is estimated at £4m. Does English Heritage have funding in place for the project, or is it the intention to secure definite funding once the contest concludes?	The funding is in place.	26-Jun-15
9	As landscape architect from Luxembourg, can I participate to the competition ?	English Heritage is seeking a team led by either an architect or a design engineer. Please note landscaping skills are not required at this stage.	26-Jun-15

10	I would like to enter the Tintagel Competition, but as a non-UK architecture firm, it's not clear how should I fill some of the PQQ document sections, like the C2 (financial requirements) or C4 (insurance infos).	Please fill in the information as requested, indicating where you have used the equivalent in your county.	26-Jun-15
11	Can Joint Ventures enter the competition? If so, do they need to set up as a new JV legal entity at time of entering the competition?	Joint Ventures can enter the competition. There is no need to form a legal entity at this stage. Further details on the anticipated contractual arrangements will be given at tender stage.	26-Jun-15
12	Is it possible for a non-UK registered company to take the Lead Consultant role?	Yes.	26-Jun-15
13	Is there a minimum turnover requirement?	No.	26-Jun-15
14	Is it acceptable for a team to comprise non-UK registered company Consultants?	Yes.	26-Jun-15
15	Can a newly set up UK company (RIBA Chartered Architects) take part in the competition?	Yes, providing the company meets the criteria as set out in the PQQ.	26-Jun-15
16	In your details for the competition, it mentions that within the Team of people, there must be an Architect or Design Engineer? I am a Part 1 Architect, currently in my year out, would this suffice for the Team requirements?	The team must be led by either a qualified architect or qualified design engineer.	26-Jun-15
